Before you apply for a work permit, you need these documents to include in your application:

1. a copy of the nomination letter from the Government of Yukon confirming that you've been nominated for permanent residence
2. a signed letter of support from the Government of Yukon stating:
3. that the employers who are offering you the jobs need you to work in the community as soon as possible
4. that the job offers are genuine
5. the details of the job offers, including:

6. names of the employers
7. occupation
8. number of hours
9. job locations
